

# Choose Your Own Patchwork Adventure!



## HOW DOES IT WORK?

You choose the size/type of project you'd like to work on—eg. table runner, cushion, bag, sampler blocks, row by row quilt, medallion/frame quilt.

You choose your own fabrics and sew your own individual project your way.

Every month from January to June 2025 two clues/options are drawn at the monthly BMQ Stitches' Gathering.

It's up to you how you interpret each month's clues/options. You might use both, one or none that month.

There are examples of possible clues/options below.

You are most welcome to suggest clues/options—give them to Michelle or Ruth (so we can check for duplicates before adding them to the draw).

Each month's clues/options will also be put on the BMQ website and social media.

As the clues/options are being drawn at our Stitches' Gathering, the possibility is there for participants to get together for catchup and conversation about our patchwork adventures and ideas and to enjoy seeing each other's works in progress.

## SAMPLE MATHS FOR A FRAME/ MEDALLION QUILT

Centre 12in finished (made ahead of time)

If you make six borders, one each month, and each border is 4in finished, each border adds 8in to the quilt.

12in centre + 48in = 60in square quilt

A quilt of this size would require approximately 4-5 metres of fabric or 16-20 fat quarters.
